

**Report by PTL**  
**On Application for Change CMR002**  
**Proposed Change to the Transportation Code Modification Rules**

**Introduction**

Premier Transmission Limited (PTL) has prepared this report in accordance with section 12.4 of its Transportation Code Modification Rules.

The proposed changes to the Transportation Code Modification Rules arise from the requirement to amend reference errors in the current version of the Transportation Code Modification Rules, (version 2.0 18<sup>th</sup> April 2005) and to enable NIAER, Gas Suppliers and Shippers to communicate via email, an address for notification as apposed to hardcopy writing. The objective of the proposed changes is to ensure accuracy and clarity when making reference to clauses within the Modification Rules and references to PTL License conditions and to make the notification of address process more efficient for NIAER, Gas Suppliers and Shippers.

**Description of the objective of the proposed change**

**Proposed text amending the Modification Rules**

1. Correction of reference in section 4, Preliminary Determination - clause 4.1 (b)

4.1 (b) any Alternative Procedure issued by Premier Transmission in accordance with section 10, should be adopted;

2. Correction of reference in section 10, Alternative Procedure for substantial review of part of the Transportation Code - clause 10.6

10.6 A Consultee may, within 10 business days from the date that the Alternative Procedure was issued, request a Preliminary Determination as to whether the Alternative Procedure proposed should be adopted in accordance with section 4,

Deleted: .1 (c)

3. Correction of reference in "relevant objective" definition in Definitions and Interpretation section 10.

"relevant objective" shall have the meaning given to it in Condition 2.4.1 of the Licence subject to the additional requirement set out in Standard Condition 2A.7.2;

4. Amendment to the "Notice" clause to make the notification of address process more efficient for NIAER, Gas Suppliers and Shippers

- 13.1 Any notice or other communication given or made by any person under these Rules shall be: (a) in writing and may be (i) delivered by hand to the addressee; (ii) sent by first class prepaid letter, to the address of the addressee; (iii) sent by fax to the addressee's fax transmission number specified in writing by the addressee or such other address or number as may be notified by a person from time to time in writing for this purpose; or (iv) sent by email to an email address, communicated by email or specified in writing by the addressee or such other address or number as may be notified by a person from time to time in writing for this purpose; and

#### **Impact on other DPO Modification Rules**

PTL acknowledges that the other DPOs may not have the same reference errors as detailed above but may want to include the clause outlined in point 4 above.
